

A Dozen Spring Eggs

Directions: (There are extra eggs if you want to use more than a dozen.)

Color and decorate the eggs. Carefully cut each egg on the outside line. Recycle an empty, clean container to hold your eggs; pretend it is a basket or nest. Choose one of the activities listed below.

Half Dozen Things to Do with a Dozen Spring Eggs

1. Count aloud and find the correct number as you count.
2. Shake up the eggs in the container. Close your eyes. Have a friend take one or more eggs out of the container. Can you guess which eggs are missing?
3. Use a large collection of beans, buttons or small pieces of candy. Count out the correct number of pieces to match the number on each egg.
4. Shake up the eggs in the container. Close your eyes and choose an egg. Say or write that number of nice things about the person sitting next to you.
5. Choose two eggs. Add the numbers together, say the sum aloud or write it down.
6. Choose two or more eggs. Place them next to each other on a flat surface and create a very large number. Try to say the new number. Can you count that far? Try it!
